A Few Notes

We have a few requests & want to let you know a few things to make your stay more pleasant;

Please park on the street in front of the house. Your car will be safe there and not have to experience the damage caused by the big dip in the driveway when you try and pull in.

Please take your shoes off upon entering the house from any direction. There is a closet by the entrance door that you are welcome to put them in.

The bathroom sink has a gravity issue given its design. If you turn the water down to almost off after initially turning it on for a minute the water will drain out of the sink.

The dresser is an antique and therefore a bit delicate. If you want a place to put your folded things please use the cupboard to the left of the fridge in the built in wall unit.

There is a small dog living in the main house. He takes his job of protecting Jennifer quite seriously. He may bark for a moment when you first come back to the house but will settle quickly. He's a little sweetheart with a big dog personality. His name is Sebastian.
